

# A Tour site ŠEVČIN MINE

## 1 Ševčín Mine

Traditional crafts and industry in the Příbram • Drilling equipment of the Příbram mines • Development of vertical mining transport in the Příbram region • Lookout tower of the shaft building • Mining compressor dated 1928 • International significance of the Březové Hory ore mining district • History of mining in the Příbram Region • Mineralogical and geological collections, the largest sample of silver in museums of Czechia • Miner's cottage: life of the miner's family, toy-making and puppeteering

## 2 Ride by a mining train and Ševčín Adit

Ride by a mining train on 230-meter-long narrow gauge railway and through 130-meter-long Ševčín Adit

25 min, max. of 24 persons, from 3 yrs, departure times:  
9:30 10:30 11:30 12:30 13:30 14:30 15:30 16:30 17:30\*  
\*only May–June: Sat–Sun, July–August: Tue–Sun  
Last tour only includes ride by mining train

## 3 Water wheel of the Drkolnov Mine

Water wheel with a huge diameter of 12.4 m and a slide

45 min (excluding transport), max. 25 persons, from 6 yrs

The tour starts at the Ševčín Mine at 10:00, 12:00 a 14:00. Visitors will move (by car or on foot) with the guide to the Drkolnov Mine (1.5 km)

# B Tour site ANNA MINE

## 1 Ride by a mining train and steam engine

Ride by a mining train through 260 m long Prokop Adit to the pit of the deepest mine (1600 m) of the district • Steam engine Breitfeld & Daněk dated 1914 • Steam engines in the ore mining • Ore preparation and metallurgy

55 min, max. of 22 persons, from 3 yrs, guided tours start at:  
9:00 9:30 10:00 10:30 11:00 11:30 12:00 12:30 13:00  
13:30 14:00 14:30 15:00 15:30 16:00 16:30 17:00\* 17:30\*  
\*only May–June: Sat–Sun, July–August: Tue–Sun  
Last tour only includes ride by mining train

## 2 Watercourse Level – Wasserlauf

The access by a mining lift and walk through 750-meter-long underground of 16<sup>th</sup>–19<sup>th</sup> cent. with water wheel chambers

45 min, max. of 22 persons, from 6 yrs, physically demanding, exit at the Vojtěch Mine (tour site C)

## 3 Jan Mine

The access by a mining lift and walk through 810-meter-long underground of 16<sup>th</sup>–19<sup>th</sup> cent. with water wheel chambers, adit with narrow profile and short climb up by a ladder

45 min, max. of 15 persons, from 6 yrs, physically demanding  
Tours Watercourse Level and Jan Mine are organized according to what majority of visitors want to see in one of those versions: either tour 2 or tour 3 or both tours 2 and 3 together

# C Tour site VOJTĚCH MINE

## 1 Vojtěch Mine and Anna Water Adit

World's primacy in reaching 1000 m depth in the Vojtěch Mine in 1875 • Gallery of mining art by Karel Hojden painter and Václav Šára sculptor • Lookout tower of the shaft building • Steam engine Breitfeld & Daněk dated 1888, with parts of 1873, the oldest one in Czechia • Mining smithery • Anna Water Adit: 330-meter-long underground

50 min, max. of 25 persons, from 3 yrs, exit at the Anna Mine (tour site B), guided tours start at:  
9:00 10:00 11:00 12:00 13:00 14:00 15:00 16:00 17:00\*  
\*only May–June: Sat–Sun, July–August: Tue–Sun
